



# PIG WRESTLING RULES & REGULATIONS

Thursday, July 25, 2019 ♦ 7:00 PM ♦ Rodeo Arena

Please share these rules with your entire team prior to competing:

1. All teams must consist of four (4) players
2. All contestants must sign a release form; anyone under age 18 must have a parent or guardian's signature before entry will be accepted
3. All players must wear a shirt, pants, and shoes for safety reasons
4. The Team Captain is responsible for all actions of the team
5. No player may use gloves, spikes, hooks, or any other object to help catch a pig
6. There will be two (2) players on each side of the fence prior to the start of the match
7. All players must have one hand on the fence between the entry gate and the orange ribbon prior to start of match
8. The pig must be put in the barrel BUTT first
9. No hitting the pig to startle or otherwise harm the animal; this will result in disqualification of the team
10. The pig must be taken to the barrel, the barrel may not be taken to the pig
11. All matches will have a 1-minute time limit
12. All players must raise both hands in the air to complete the match
13. All players must stay and help unload the pig out of the barrel when the match is complete
14. The judge's rule is final
15. All contestants must stay out of the grandstands seating area and restrooms after competing

**Any abuse to the pig will be an automatic disqualification of the team**
